- Greases for high precision and low-friction motion control
- Lubrication under extreme temperatures, loads, or contamination
- Lubrication of equipment operating in remote or inaccessible locations
- Smart lubrication, condition monitoring, and predictive maintenance
- Sustainability and energy efficiency in advanced machinery
- Material compatibility in robotics and lightweight equipment
- Novel grease technologies for next-generation applications
- Case studies, field experience, and validation methods for demanding environments
